Ms. Nino Gokhelashvili is Vice-Chairperson of the Bureau of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention).

Nino Gokhelashvili is Head of Sustainable Development Division of the Department of Environment and Climate Change at the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Agriculture of Georgia.
